



Homelessness in children is a devastating condition that disrupts their development, their security, and their education. Fortunately, there is a safe and nurturing place for Sacramento's neediest children—the Mustard Seed School. Part of Loaves and Fishes, the Mustard Seed School provides learning and love to these displaced kids, often serving as an island of hope in their disrupted world. The school relies solely on private funds to continue their good work each year.

The Mustard Seed Spin is a charity bike ride benefiting the Mustard Seed School and we are in the planning stages for our 4th annual event, which will take place on Sunday, September 28, 2008. In addition to generating a donation to the Mustard Seed School, this fun ride introduces young people and their families to organized cycling.

The ride was first organized in 2005 by a group of community volunteers and in three years, grew to 550 riders. At the Mustard Seed Spin, helmets and bikes are checked for fit and safety, rules of the road are reviewed and riders are treated to healthy refreshments at the rest stop and the finish line of the 20 mile course, with a bike quiz and raffle after the ride. In 2007, we were able to contribute \$24,500 to the Mustard Seed School!
